At the annual NCSHRM State Conference, the State Council will announce the winner **Jan Sharp Memorial Scholarship** *(endowed by Capitol Broadcasting Company)*. The State Council will award 1 scholarship annually to a student in the Eastern half of the State of North Carolina. The Program will be administered as follows:

- ◆ The amount of the scholarship is **\$1,000** to a student**
- ◆ Each student chapter will receive the NC State Council Scholarship Self- Nomination Forms along with application requirements. In addition, a mailing will be sent to each student chapter member with a self-nomination form.
- ◆ Scholarship nomination criteria will be equally based upon the student's contributions to the student chapter and academic performance, along with involvement with community or school activities; and commitment to the Human Resources Profession.
- ◆ **Self-Nomination forms are to be submitted** by the Student to the current State Council Awards Chair **no later than May 31** of each year along with the requested recommendations.
- ◆ Students must include the required recommendation letters with the application.
- ◆ The scholarship is available to any undergraduate member of an affiliated SHRM Student Chapter.
- ◆ The scholarship is provided to current undergraduate candidates for future academic expenses. Since the scholarship is generally provided during the third calendar quarter, the recipient must be an active full-time student at the time of the award.
- ◆ The North Carolina State Council will not underwrite student attendance expenses to the State Conference to accept awards. [In the bidding process for the conference, the State Council does require that the host chapter(s) offer student members reduced conference rates].
- ◆ Decisions by Scholarship Judges are final and are not subject to review by applicants.

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS:

- 1) Please submit this cover page along with no more than a two page overview of your Human Resources interests, including classes taken or scheduled to take, student chapter participation and positions held within the chapter, grades in Human Resources' programs and in overall transcript, and internships that you have held. You might also include information regarding your extra-curricular activities and community service in his area. Your overview should clearly state how you meet the criteria above.
- 2) Please provide two written recommendations supporting your character and achievements as outlined in your two page overview as above. One recommendation **must** be from your student chapter advisor OR a Human Resources professor within your school.
